  - Lead communication to families about IEP progress
  - Lead IEP meetings
  - Communicating with families to support students and help them become advocates for their children
  - Collaborate with community agencies to help families find out of school services
- Direct Support to Teachers
  - Co-plan lessons and long term plans with general education teachers
  - Observe classes to provide suggestions for supporting students with diverse needs
  - Coordinate services between different school spaces
  - Consult with staff in ongoing planning and collaboration meetings
- Compliance with Special Education Law
  - Observe and assess students as part of the Special Education evaluation process
  - Enter notes into Compliance system
  - Participate in IEP meetings and grow to lead own meetings and manage own cases
